Science Fair June 9<sup>th</sup> – Jennifer Campbell and Sandeep Khot

Kick off meeting to take place next week. Teachers need guidance on projects they can take on, and volunteers to help out in the classroom. Parent run or teacher run? Prizes? Celebration vs. competition. Boeing SAMPE kits – could have teachers pick out a few for their classes. Have more hands-on experiments. UW Mobile Planetarium (comes with a professor). We have money available for STEM (don't include this in minutes). PSC mobile science kits. Plan for post-test season – the later in the year the better. Provide list of 3 choices per grade, with kits to choose from, for teachers. Kiwikits. Mariana can approach Boeing and KiwiCo. Have lego robotics team show their projects.

PEP

\$10K deficit for fall, broke even in winter, small deficit in the spring. \$11,400 deficit overall, before \$15,000 kick in from PTSA which will help us break even.

Alyssa working to get money (\$4-\$5K) from McKinney-Vento to help pay for costs associated with those students. Paying teachers \$15.75-\$18.00 per hour to run programs. 143 students in PEP. 260 kids at Madrona.
